Suggested Christmas Gifts

So often people think about what they want for Christmas. Some individuals even give rather strong hints as to what they would like to see under the Christmas tree with their name on it. However, we should all think about the real reason we should celebrate Christmas - it is the birthday of the Lord Jesus. It would be good to think about what we can give Jesus to celebrate His birthday.

So, what can you give to the creator of the world? The best answer is yourself! Romans 12:1 tells us to "present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service." Paul wrote these words to believers in Rome. However, before we are in a position to properly serve the Lord, we must confess our sins and invite Christ to be our Lord and Savior. In Romans 10:9-10 the Bible says "if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes to righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made to salvation."

If you have already surrendered your life to Christ and are faithfully serving Him as the Lord of your life, then there is another suggested gift for Jesus to celebrate His birth. It is a gift that helps other people come to know Him as Lord and Savior. It is a gift to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering for international missions.

Charlotte Digges Moon, better known to Southern Baptists as Lottie Moon, was appointed as a missionary to China in 1873. She served in that country for 39 years teaching in a girls' school and sharing the Gospel of Christ with women and girls in different parts of China.

It was a common practice of Lottie to send letters home from China sharing with friends and family about the Chinese culture, the needs of the people, and her life as a missionary. She would also challenge Southern Baptists to join her in missionary work in China or to give money so that others could go.

If Lottie were alive on earth today, I believe she would be communicating with Southern Baptists the same request she made long ago. She would be asking for people to serve as international missionaries or give money so that others could go.

The goal for the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering to help Southern Baptist international missionaries and the work they have been called to do is \$185 million. A generous contribution to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering would be a fitting gift for Jesus. It would be a fitting gift because you would be helping missionaries to share the Gospel of Christ with people around the world. In Luke 15:10, it is recorded that Jesus said "there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents." If the angels find joy over the salvation of a person, then it must be because God rejoices over that person's decision.

So, what can you give Jesus to celebrate His birth? First, give yourself, then share your resources so that others can come to know Jesus. These would be great gifts for our Lord.
