A special prayer emphasis began on January 9, 2021 in the Caldwell Baptist Association. The purpose of the prayer

emphasis, sponsored by the Baptist State Convention of North Carolina, is to focus attention on the lostness in the Tar Heel State. The Convention has identified 250 Pockets of Lostness in North Carolina. A pocket of lostness is where a high concentration of unchurched and unsaved people live. Three of the pockets are located in Caldwell County. Would you be willing to pray for your neighbors?

Here's what you do: (1) Sign up to pray at Pray Together. This link will take you to a simple form where you can register to participate in the prayer effort. Please indicate "Unifour" for the area when you register. Then (2), go pray. Walk or drive through your neighborhood, saturating your neighbors in prayer, particularly those who do not know Christ. It is a very simple activity, but one that could have eternal results. If you cross paths with one or more neighbors, then as the Holy Spirit leads you, talk with them about the Lord. Do this "Scattered Prayer Walk or Drive" activity when it is convenient for you. You may wish to walk with your spouse or another family member or friend. Due to the virus, please keep the group of prayer walkers small.
